
#### REPORT

### REPORT

Nabagram Amar Chand Kundu College celebrates the 125th birth anniversary of Kazi Nazrul Islam, the National Poet and an eminent figure in Bangla literature on May 26, 2023. Kazi Nazrul Islam's iconic poem 'Bidrohi' (The Rebel) and his debut poetry collection 'Agnibeena' (The Fiery Lute) left an indelible mark on Bangla literature for a hundred years. His poems continue to inspire and resonate with themes of social justice, freedom, and the spirit of resistance. He was born in 1306 in the Churulia village of Asansol, West Bengal. His works encompassed a wide range of emotions, from love and harmony to the plight of the common people. He started his career as a band player and worked as a bakery laborer. His early experiences of hardship and struggle deeply influenced his poetry, which often highlighted the struggles of the working class and the oppressed. He also engaged in journalism and worked at HMV and Calcutta Betar, further expanding his influence and reach. Joining the anti-British movement, he faced imprisonment, yet his literary pursuits remained paramount throughout his life. Nazrul also made significant contributions to Bangla music, pioneering a distinct genre and introducing Bangla Ghazal. His compositions are still cherished and performed today, reflecting his deep connection to the culture and spirit of Bengal. The some students performed 'Nazrul Geeti' and recited few well known poems of Kazi Nazrul Islam. The teacher-in-charge of the college and the HOD of Bengali Department delivered their valuable speeches on the relevance of the observation of Nazrul's birth anniversary. In their speeches they enlightened how the poems written by Kazi Nazrul Islam are timeless and highly relevant in the current socio-political condition we are living in, and how his poems conveyed a powerful message of religious harmony and social integrity.


Outcomes: The outcomes of this celebration are
